A PEP is a **statutory requirement** to ensure that a record is maintained regarding the child's educational progress and thus it forms an integral part of the child's overall care plan.

We have made many changes to ePEP over the summer to try to capture the child's voice in a more succinct way but also to try and make the process more slim lined for our Designated Teachers. In the training we will also be reviewing SMART targets which some settings have previously struggled with and additionally funding.

The training is virtual and we look forward to welcoming new and 'old' faces on Monday 18th September at 3.30pm.

New Film and Screen National Saturday Club

A new **FREE** <u>Film and Screen Saturday Club</u> which includes visits to professional studios and masterclasses with film and media industry professionals with travel costs included.

The programme will run from 7th October 2023 to 18th May 2024, 10am to 1pm, every Saturday during term time and is based at Wokingham and Bracknell College.

The club is for young people from 13 to 16 years, who are from low-income families, looked after children, or have parents or carers who have not been to university.

Through a combination of creativity, imagination and learning technical skills, sessions explore film and screen production, sound and lighting design to visual effects and animation. It gives a great start to young people's creative journey and opens their eyes to the vast opportunities this industry has to offers.

No previous experience of film is required. There are only 25 places and offered on a first come first served basis, so <u>book now</u>!
